How to Connect the 1:10 HDMI 1.3 DA to your devices

- 1. Connect the supplied cable from the HDTV HDMI source into the 1:10 HDMI 1.3 DA input.
- 2. Connect the cables from your displays (monitor or projector) into the HDMI outs of the 1:10 HDMI 1.3 DA.
- 3. Plug the 24VDC power supply into the 1:10 HDMI 1.3 DA.

EDID SWITCH

The HDMI 1:10 has an EDID Switch which will determine if you are going to use the EDID from the display attached to output 1 or use an onboard EDID.

If you want to use the EDID from the display attached to output 1, make sure the switch is selected to "EXT".

If you want to use the onboard EDID, make sure the switch is selected to "INT" which will give you a generic EDID of 1080i.
